1

Create an LSAC account.

Register with [LSAC.org](https://lsac.org). Then create an account to apply. Be sure to add Hofstra Law to your school list; our school code is 2295. Online applications do not require a fee.

2

Apply online.

When filling out your application, be sure to select the program that you want to apply to (JD, JD/MBA, JD/MPH, etc.). Also make certain that you select full-time or part-time day.

3

Submit your supporting materials.

No application will be considered complete until your supporting materials have been received and processed. [Click here](#) for the checklist of requirements.

Once you have submitted your application, you will receive a decision in about four weeks. We look forward to reviewing your application.
